- A basic understanding of all aspects of farm management and biosecurity
- Capacity to collect and analyse data relating to farm management practices
- Understanding of agricultural and environmental policies/guidelines and management
- Demonstrated experience in community consultation and engagement
- Demonstrated skills in rural extension
- Demonstrated ability to build networks

This position requires at least 5 years' experience in agriculture extension (preferably in Tasmania) and a degree in Agriculture or Horticulture, and/or a related science.
