The Graduate Program

RMCG's Graduate Program will provide you with challenging and meaningful work, and structured professional development to help you navigate the beginning of your career.

We will work with each graduate to develop a program that features at least three placements (of approximately four months) within RMCG. You'll work from a central office location but some travel between offices and client sites will be expected. There is also an opportunity for each placement to be held at a different office location if convenient.

As a graduate you will:

- Be a part of and work with a diverse team of professionals
- Work across several technical disciplines
- Be involved in interesting and challenging projects
- Have access to both internal and external learning and development opportunities
- Learn and grow with mentors and a network of peers.

We will provide:

- A 12-month program, with 3 placements of approximately 4 months at a time
- The opportunity to develop technical knowledge and skills by working with and learning from others
- The ability to explore different areas of interest across the business

- Structured training to become a great consultant
- Access to mentoring and supervision that will guide and support you throughout the year
- A competitive starting salary of \$75,000 including super.



What our program involves

Our Graduate Program aims to equip you with real-world knowledge and skills to work in agriculture, the environment and community sector. You will be provided with a 12-month program that includes professional development opportunities, field work, mentoring and support. Your peers will also be a great resource to provide additional support and undertake training activities.

You will be allocated a professional development budget. To develop your financial management skills you will monitor and manage your budget throughout your program.

PLANNING AND EVALUATION

At the beginning of a placement you will meet with your nominated supervisor and the rotation lead to discuss and set specific goals for the rotation. You will meet again at the completion of the placement to discuss achievements, performance and any areas to focus on in the next rotation.

At the end of the program, you will be expected to prepare and document your learnings and experiences to be presented at a combined staff meeting.

PROGRAM COORDINATION

Your day-to-day RMCG contact will be your nominated supervisor and managers or projects you are working on.

The Graduate Program will be managed by our HR Co-ordinator who can answer any questions about your placement.

Our ideal candidate


We are looking for graduates with qualifications and an interest in the following areas:

- Environment Catchment management, biodiversity and conservation management, water for the environment, project planning and analysis, resource recovery and waste management.
- Water Integrated water management (IWM), irrigation design and management, recycled water and domestic wastewater management, groundwater analysis, water quality and salinity
- Economics Financial and economic analysis in water, agriculture and the environment including regulation and pricing, socio-economic and regional impact assessment, benchmarking, cost-benefit analysis and business case development, circular economy.

STAGE 1:

APPLICATION - OCTOBER 2024

We also require a **copy of your academic transcript** or a statement verifying your qualifications if obtained overseas.

STAGE 2: INTERVIEW - OCTOBER 2024

We will shortlist applications and advise if you have been successful in progressing to an interview. We will also contact unsuccessful applicants.

At the interview you will be invited to talk about your skills, experience, achievements and what you can bring to RMCG. You will also have the opportunity to ask questions of the interview panel.

STAGE 3: OFFER - NOVEMBER 2024
